

Intercounty Electric Cooperative Association (IECA) is seeking a full-time dispatcher for the Licking district office. The position is regularly scheduled evenings, overnights and week-end evening work, the position may entail extra hours when additional staff is required for the Dispatch Department. The starting pay rate will be \$21.50 per hour.
