Under the direction of the Lead Facilities Maintenance Worker, the Facilities Maintenance Worker will perform a variety of semi-skilled work in the maintenance of Cooperative properties and other related duties as assigned.

Individual must obtain a valid Class E license within 120 days after being hired.
