

Intercounty Electric Cooperative Association (IECA) has two openings for Linemen. **Apprentice Lineman/Journeyman Lineman preferred**; non-exempt positions. These positions will initially report to the Licking warehouse but have the potential to be relocated to another warehouse within the IECA service area. These positions have generous full-time benefits including health, dental, vision, life, and disability insurance, paid time off, paid holidays, and a defined benefit retirement plan.

Under the direction of a Construction Foreman, the Apprentice Lineman and Journeyman Lineman will perform highly skilled work in installation, maintenance and repair of the electrical utility overhead and underground distribution system.

Applicants are required to have a high school diploma or equivalent. Journeyman shall have certification of completion of an approved electrical lineman apprentice program.

Applicants selected must successfully complete a pre-employment drug screening, pre-employment background check, and a post-offer WorkSTEPS functional employment test.
