

Rate adjustment reminder

Effective April 1, 2021

Just a reminder, Intercounty's rate adjustment will be effective next month — beginning April 1. The rate adjustment decreases the kWh charge from \$0.08606 to \$0.084827 and increases the service availability rate from \$1.19 to \$1.24 per day for residential and small commercial (single phase) members.

The adjustment is detailed to the right. Notice, the kWh charge decreases while the service availability increases by \$0.05 per day.

This is in an effort to establish a rate schedule in which the co-op can better stabilize financial uncertainties caused by weather fluctuations. Long term, the co-op wants to see a rate in which kWh charges are essentially a pass-through of wholesale costs from the power supplier and the service availability rate takes care of the operations necessary to reliably deliver power.
